# ABOUT LUKE

Luke Hermanson tragically died in a car accident at the age of eighteen on January 13, 2017. Although we feel like his death was premature we know that God's will is very good and is better than ours (Isaiah 55:9). While God may have done writing Luke's story on earth he isn't done with yours and Luke would want TC to be part of that story. Luke became a Christian at age 14. He loved everything about the outdoors and that is where he spent most of his time. He spent many weekends and summers serving God here at TC. Luke might not be with us on earth anymore, but he is with Jesus worshipping and experiencing life to the full without sin. Luke's death reminds us that God holds a good plan for all His children (Romans 8:28). Through his death he gave others life by donating his organs. Only time will tell what other amazing things God has in store through the testimony of Luke's life.

## **"Everything is going to the dump."**

This was one of Luke's favorite things to say. Maybe we should explain. Luke was thrifty and often came back with treasures from the dump when all he was supposed to do was drop off trash. He loved recycling and always found uses for other people's trash. Luke's dad used to tell him, "Everything is going to the dump" meaning that things will rot and break. Things of God however, will last forever. Luke was encouraged to put his hope, time, and money into things that would last past his short life. You have the privilege of reading how he came to have a relationship with Jesus in his own words below.

Matthew 6:19-21 "Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be."

*I remember thinking when I was eleven or twelve that I was already "saved" but I just needed to make sure by doing some extra "good things." That wasn't the answer by the way.
