Dear Retreat leader,

Our goal in hosting a retreat is to provide groups with as high a level of Christ-centered encouragement and satisfaction as possible. To ensure that we are able to meet your goals and expectations, it is important that you understand what to expect and what we can offer. We welcome and encourage you to come visit our facilities prior to your retreat.

Lodging Facilities

The Big House- 3 story, 5 bedroom, 4 bathrooms (Accommodates 28)

- Dining room
- Upstairs and downstairs living room
- Second floor balcony overlooking two ponds
- Billiard room

(2) Cabins (Accommodate 24 each)

- Bunk style
- Central HVAC
- 4 Private showers

Guests must provide linens/towels for all lodging facilities

The "Seed House" Chapel (Seats 80)

Meals

Your group will have the option to have meals prepared for you or to use our facilities to prepare meals for yourselves. It would be our pleasure to prepare meals for you. However, if your group chooses to prepare their own meals, there will be a one-time fee to cover utility expenses. You will also need to provide plates and paper products. Activities

Camp activities include Team Building, Adventure Course, Paintball, Rifle and Skeet, Archery, Canoeing, Fishing, 500' Zip Line, Swimming, Nature Trails, Hunting, Night Games, Rope Maze.

Expectations

- A non-refundable deposit (20% of retreat total) is required to hold dates.
- Balance must be paid upon arrival. Changes to contract may be made up to one week before retreat. NOTE: No refunds will be made for less than expected

attendance. For more than expected attendance, additional amount owed can be paid at time of event.

-We request a copy of the retreat schedule two weeks ahead of time so we can adequately meet your needs during your stay.

-For groups 18 and younger, we require at least one chaperone per cabin for over night events.

-Leave lodging/meeting areas clean and in the order they were found.

-Obey all posted and spoken rules while on camp property.

Take Pinewood Road toward Pinewood.

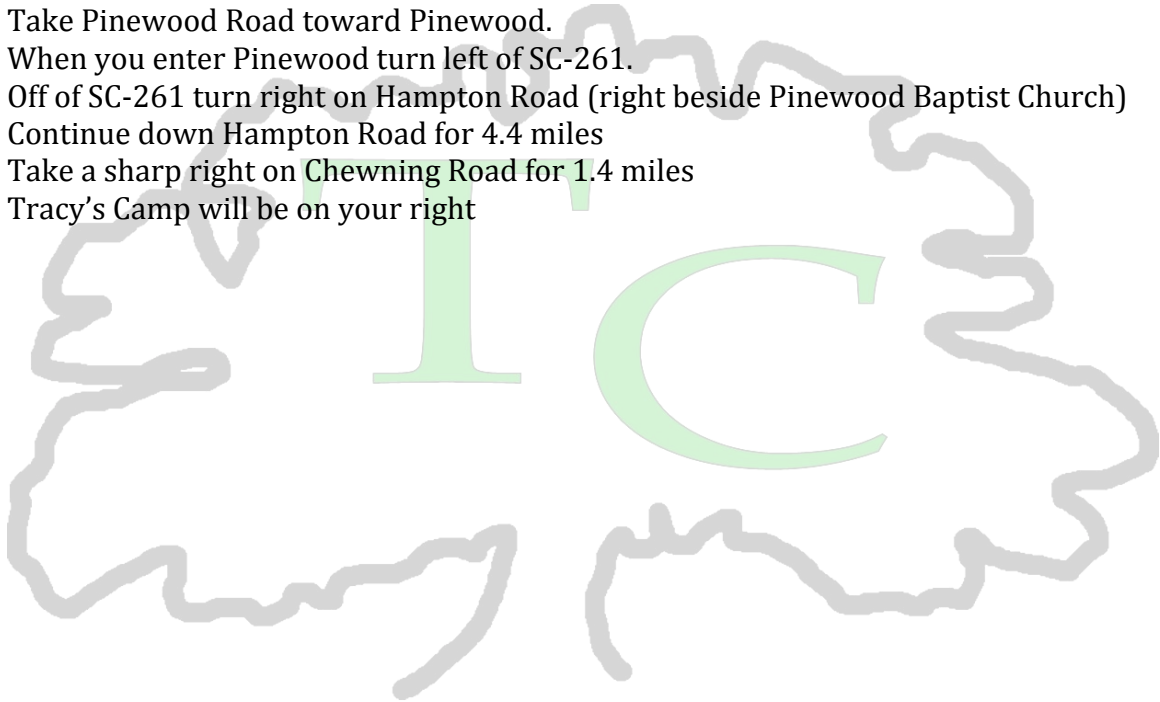
When you enter Pinewood turn left of SC-261.
