#### Meals

Your group will have the option to have meals prepared for you or to use our facilities to prepare meals for yourselves. It would be our pleasure to prepare meals for you. However, if your group chooses to prepare their own meals, there will be a one-time fee to cover utility expenses. *You will also need to provide plates and paper products.* See contract for all pricing.

#### **Activities**

Camp activities include Team Building Adventure Course, Paintball, Rifle and Skeet, Archery, Canoeing, Fishing, Mud Course, 500' Zip Line, Swimming, Nature Trail, Night Games, Rope Maze.

### **Camp Rules**

- No food in cabins or bedrooms. Please keep food only in eating areas
- No one is allowed in the room of the opposite gender.
- At least one male and one female chaperone is required for every group.
- No alcohol or firearms are allowed on the property. If you bring a firearm for skeet shooting or hunting, it must be locked up by TC staff upon arrival.

# **Policies & Expectations**

- -A non-refundable deposit (20% of retreat total) is required to hold dates.
- -Balance must be paid upon arrival. Changes to contract may be made up to one week before retreat. NOTE: No refunds will be made for less than expected attendance. For more than expected attendance, additional amount owed can be paid at time of event.
- -We request a copy of the retreat schedule two weeks ahead of time so we can adequately meet you needs during your stay.
- -For groups 18 and younger, we require at least one chaperone per cabin for over night events.
- -Leave lodging/meeting areas clean and in the order they were found.

  No cleaning is required outside of moving furniture and chairs back to their original location. Please be sure to set rooms back up as they were when you arrived upon departure
- -Obey all posted and spoken rules while on camp property.

From Sumter

Take Pinewood Road toward Pinewood.

When you enter Pinewood turn left of SC-261.

Off of SC-261 turn right on Hampton Road (right beside Pinewood Baptist Church)

Continue down Hampton Road for 4.4 miles

Take a sharp right on Chewning Road for 1.4 miles

In 1.4 miles turn right on Crooked Pine Trail. (Marked with Tracy's Camp Sign)

Continue down dirt road to the Tracy's Camp Entrance

From Columbia

Follow US-378 E/US-76 E to SC-261 E in Sumter County

Slight right onto SC-261 E continue 16.3 mi

Turn right onto County Rd S-43-97/S Hampton St (Right after Pinewood Baptist

Church) Continue 4.4 miles

Turn hard right onto Chewning Rd/State Rd S-14-60 continue 1.4 mi

Turn right on Crooked Pine Trail. (Marked with Tracy's Camp Sign)

Continue down dirt road to the Tracy's Camp Entrance

From Charleston/Summerton

Take I-26 to I-95 NWW.tracyscamp.com

Take exit 108

Turn Left onto Buff Blvd/State Road S-14-102

Turn Right at stop sign onto Church Street in .9 Miles

Turn Left on Main Street in .7 Miles

Continue for 8 Miles then take a right on Chewning Road

\*If you see Rimini you have gone too far

Turn left on Crooked Pine Trail in 1.1 miles (Marked with Tracy's Camp Sign)

Continue down dirt road to the Tracy's Camp Entrance
